With a combined total legacy of more than 100 years, the SpartanNash Foundation is committed to providing hunger relief, securing shelter and supporting our military heroes in the communities we serve.



In 2019, more than 37 million people in the United States struggled with hunger. Each year, our wholesale and MDV distribution centers personally select **local food pantries** to receive \$5,000 donations through the Foundation. This annual tradition goes back to 2004, with the company's distribution centers donating more than \$1 million to community food banks and pantry partners as a result.



Shelter

Open Door Mission is working to break the cycle of homelessness and poverty throughout the Omaha/SW Iowa area through hands on programs and services. Each night, ODM offers 917 safe shelter beds to people experiencing homelessness and more than 4,747 nutritious meals daily to hungry people. Through life-changing programming, ODM celebrated 48 graduates of the New Life Recovery and Journey to Work Programs. Service to our nation is not a new concept to Matt Kiddoo, whose family legacy includes 10 members who have served our country in uniform. He retired from the Air Force after serving 20 years as an Aircraft Armament Systems Specialist, and his drive to serve others now includes **Team Red, White and Blue**. "The sense of belonging, camaraderie, and inclusiveness that Team RWB provides is exactly what I was missing, what I needed, after I retired," Kiddoo said.
